Poll on pesticide use in Cambodia

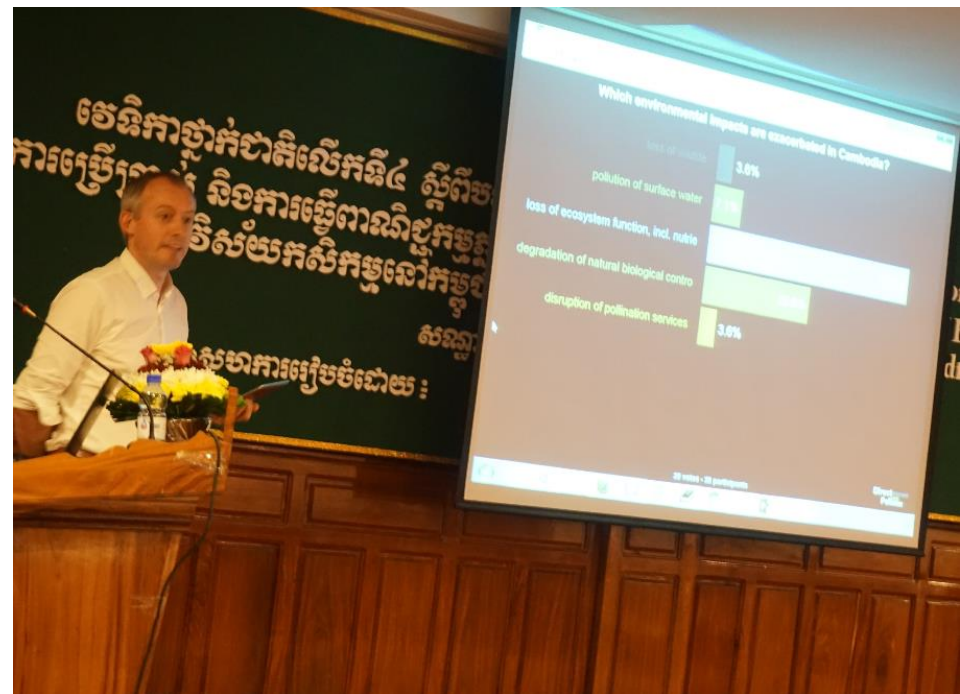

Methodology

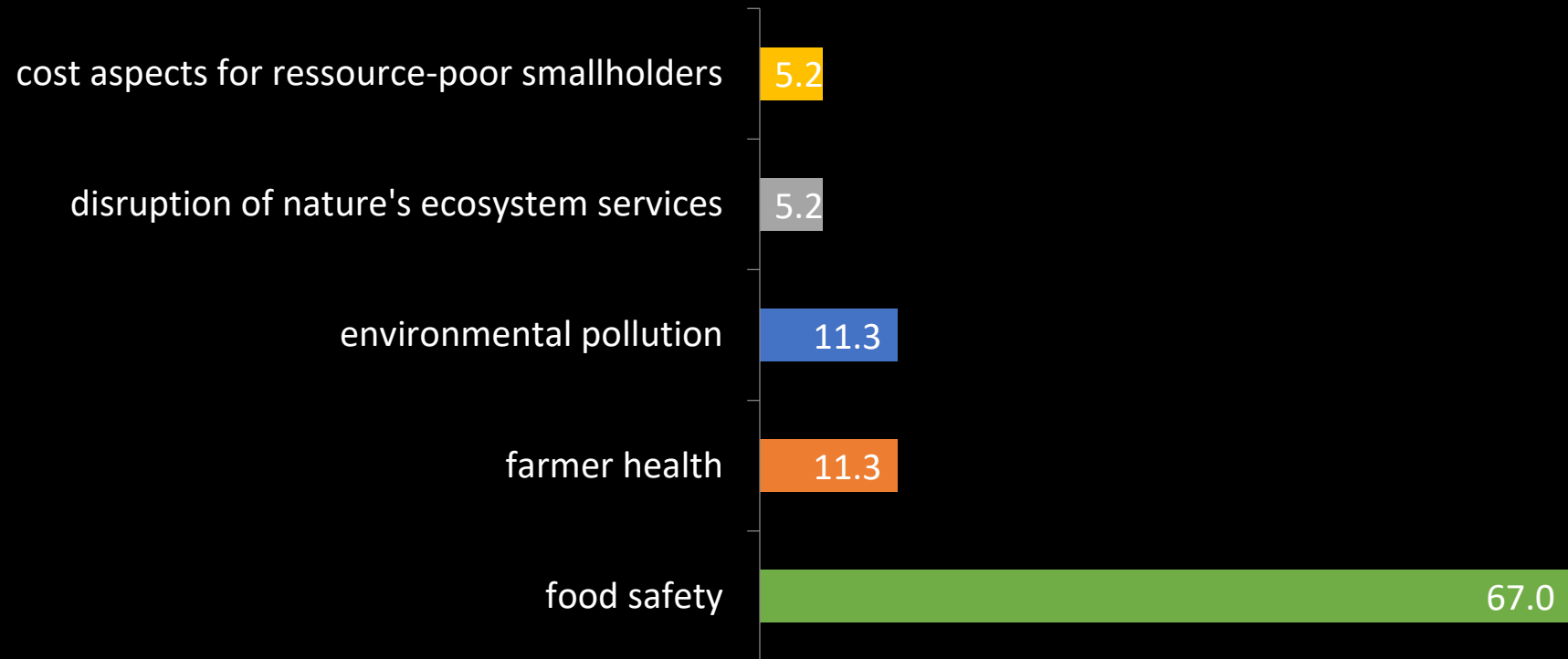
The questionnaire was jointly designed by CIAT, IRRI and GIZ. The online tool [DirectPoll](#) enabled the participants to directly send their votes via Smartphone and in real time follow the poll on the screen. The questions were translated into khmer and the team assisted to use the tool. votes of those who had no smartphone were elicited and summarized on flipchart paper. A range of 72-97 participants voted for each question. Participants came from 12 Cambodian provinces. 27% were farmer, 27% representatives of MAFF, 12% from local companies and 34% from local NGOs.

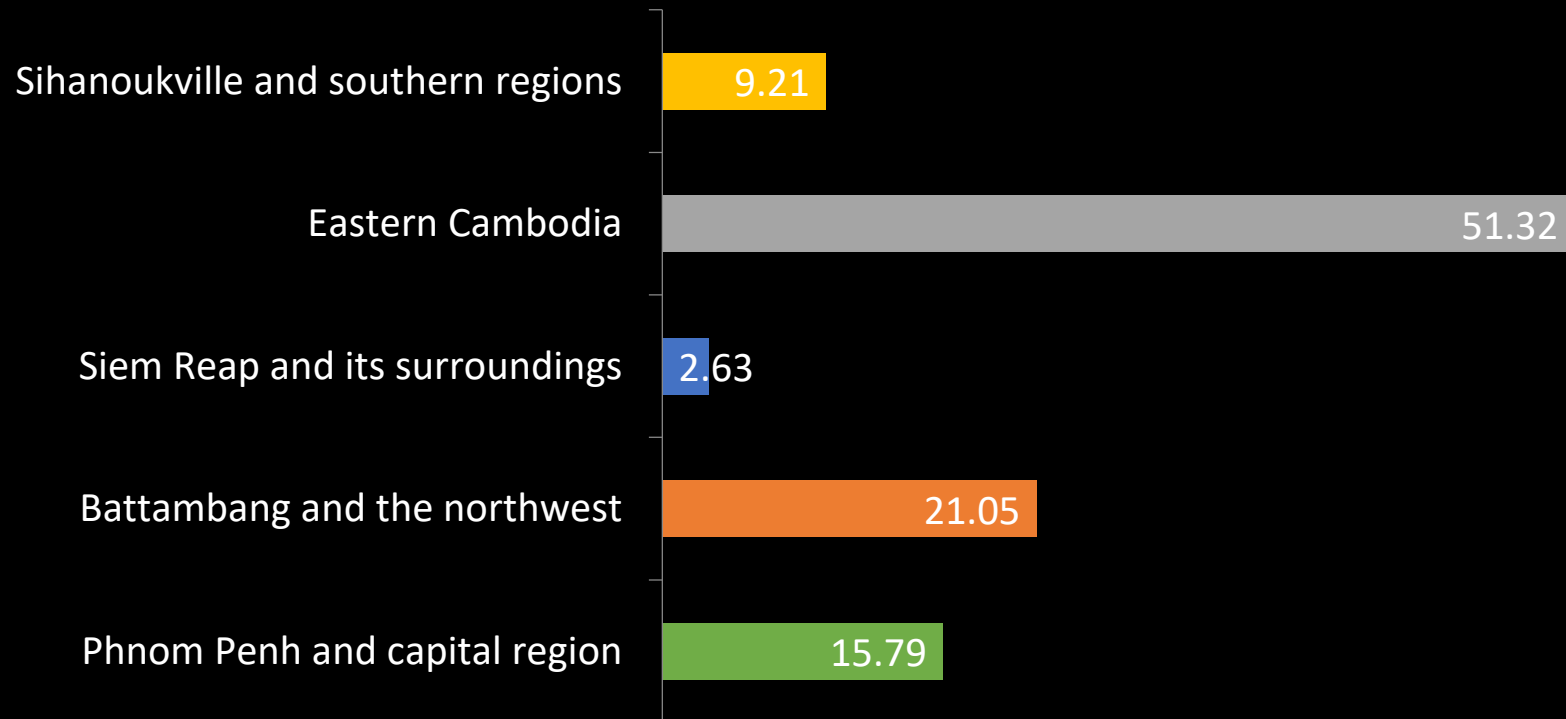
What are the primary concerns related to pesticide over-use in Cambodia?



Total responds: 97



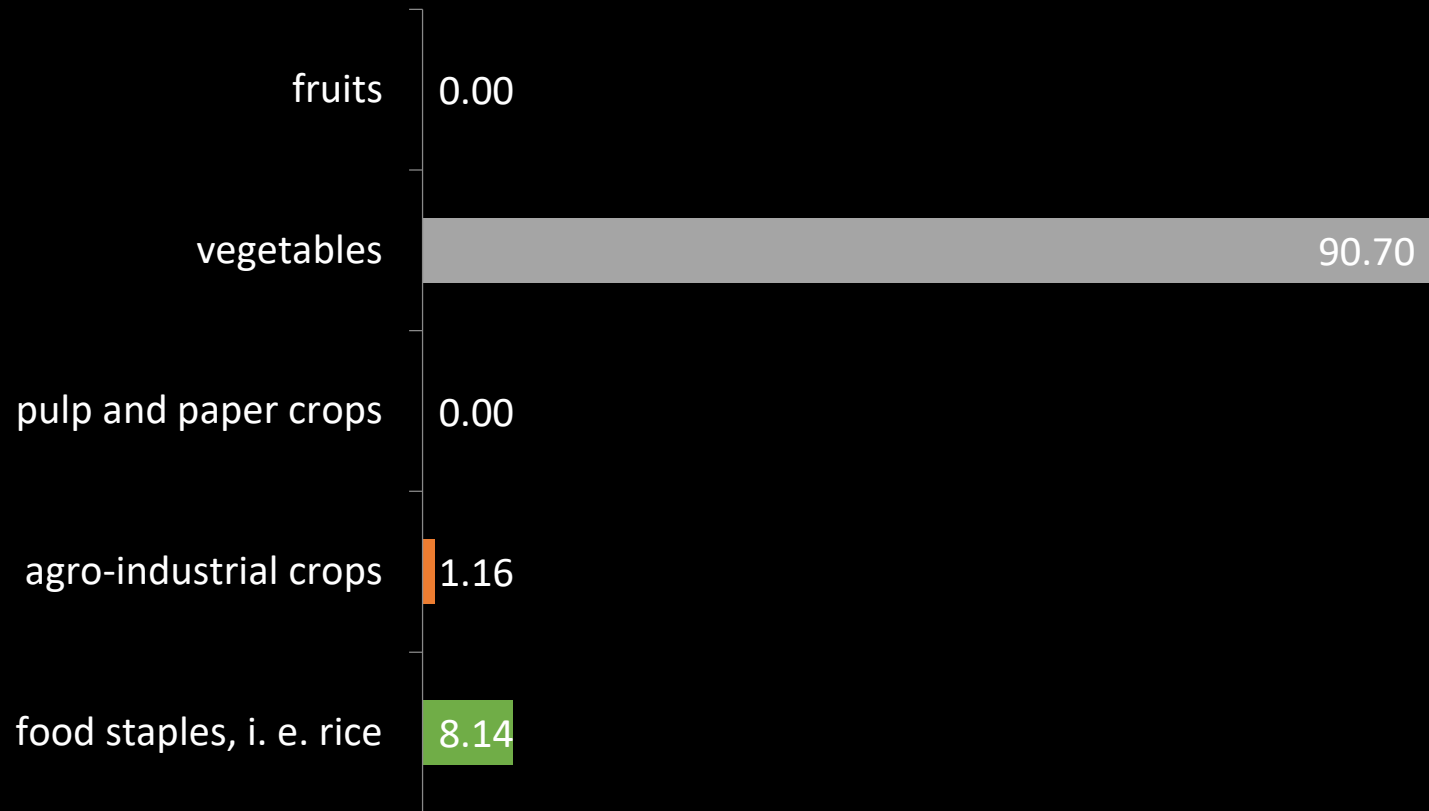
Which geographies are high on the list in terms of pesticide over-use?



Total responds: 76



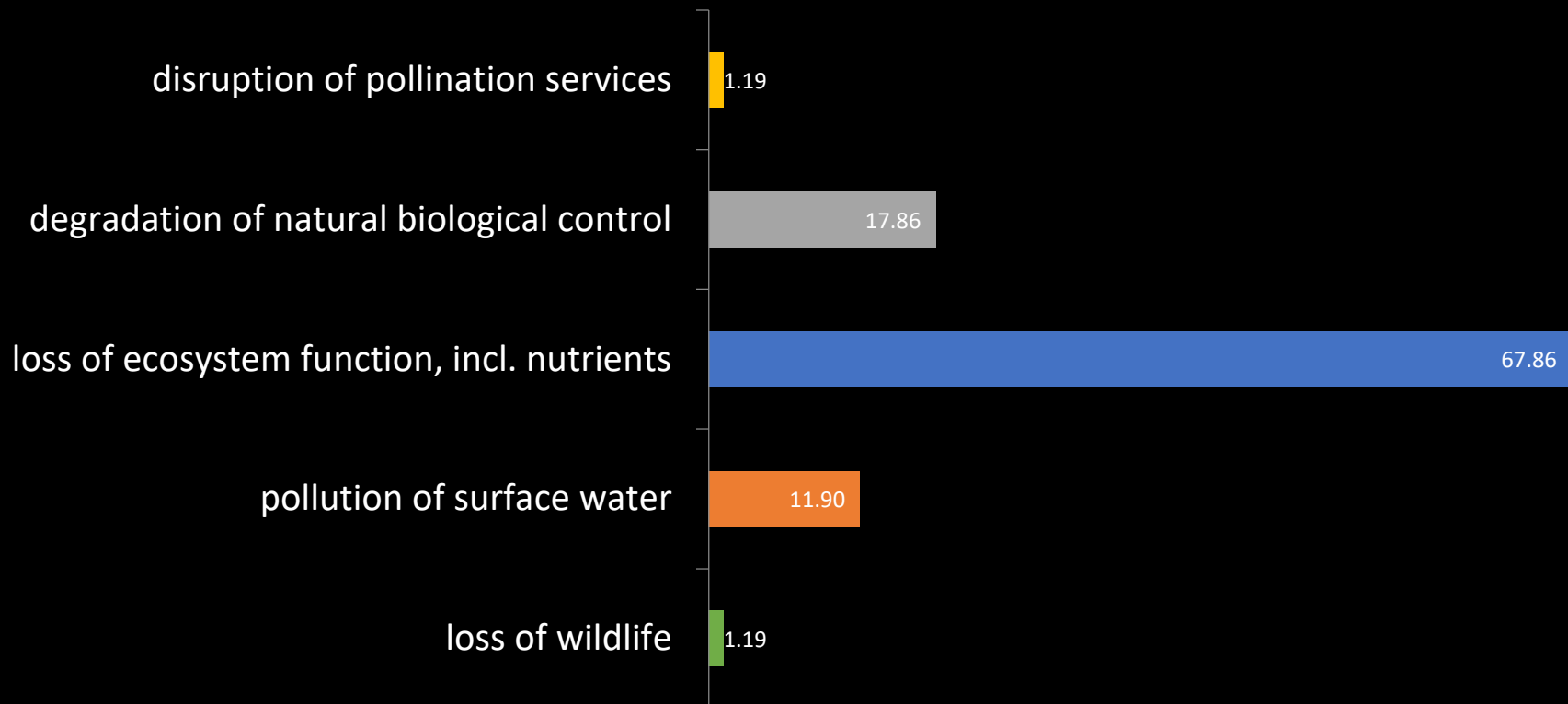
What target commodities receive most pesticide use?

Total responds: 84



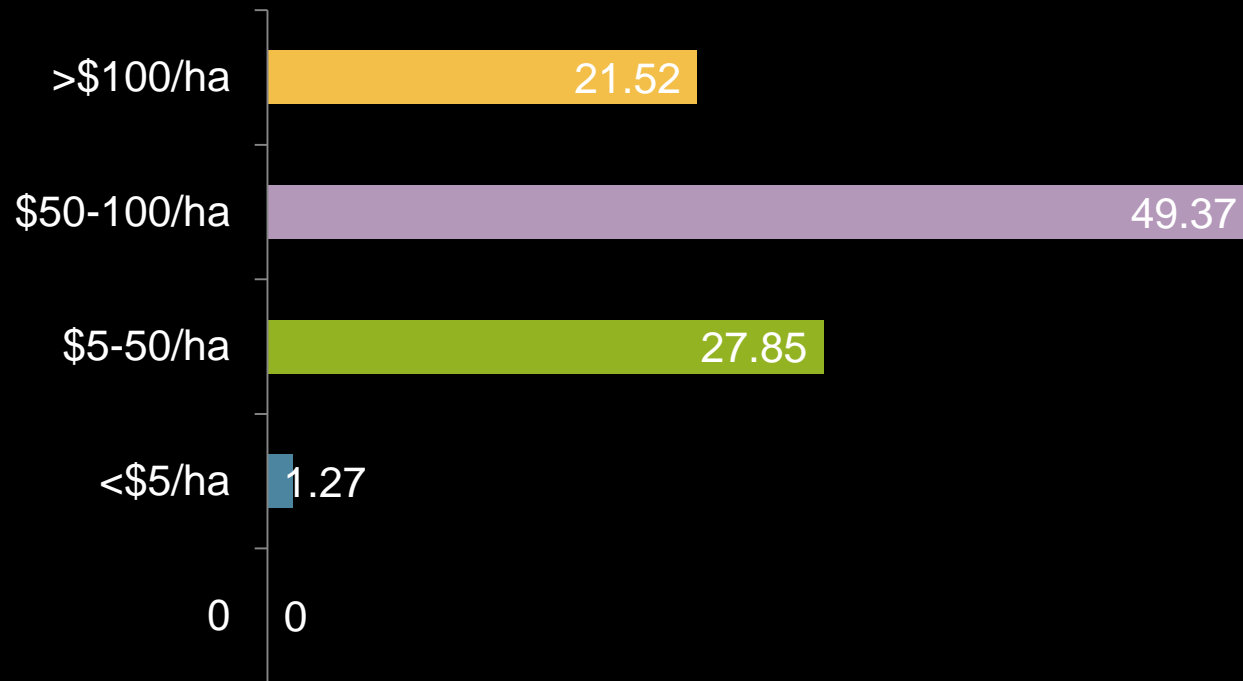
Which vegetable crops in Cambodia are of major concern from a pesticide over-use angle?



Total responds: 72



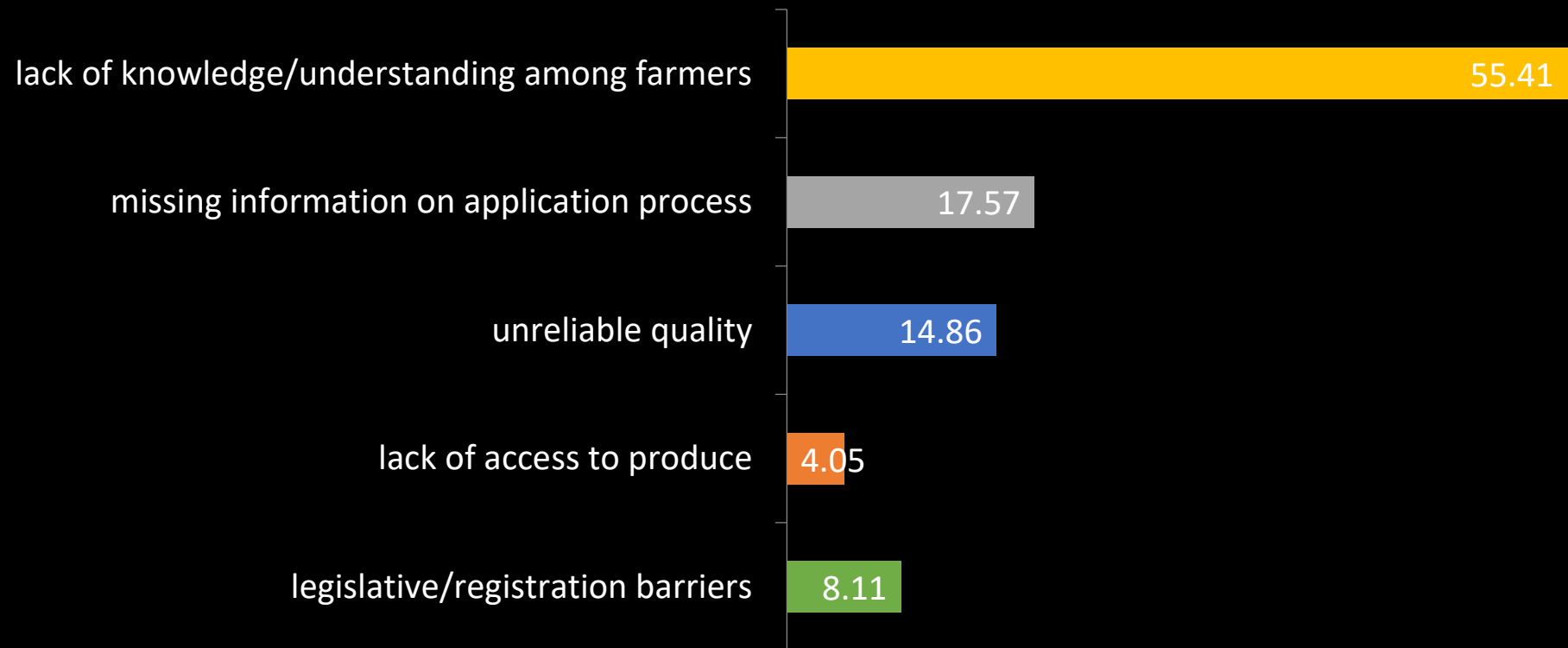
What is the economic value of services provided by insect natural enemies in Cambodia's agriculture?
