Matthias Bickel
Chairperson, Sustainable Rice Platform (SRP) Board, and

Matthias Bickel is the Director for the Cluster "Agriculture and Food" in Bangkok leading various project teams in Thailand and the ASEAN region on Sustainable Agrifood Systems, Public Private Partnerships, Supply Chain

Upgrading, Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation, and Agricultural Finance as well as Upscaling of Outreach Initiatives. He currently serves on various boards and committees including as Chairperson of the Sustainable Rice Platform Board. In 2012, Matthias was honoured as an Asia-Europe Young Leader at the Asia Pacific Conference in New Delhi. He holds degrees (master level) in Economics, in Business Administration, and in Business Law and Economic Law as well as a PhD in Public International Law from Martin-Luther University of Halle-Wittenberg, Germany.



Paul Nicholson Vice President, Rice Research and Sustainability, Olam International

Paul Nicholson is leading the rice research and sustainability efforts for Olam International in Asia. He currently sits on the Interim Board of the Sustainable Rice Platform (SRP) and oversees Olam's projects in India, Indonesia, Thailand, and Vietnam where Olam is engaged with GIZ, WSU,

and governments. Prior to this, Paul developed a broad and unique background in the commodity industry; working with everything from grains to cocoa and coffee, metals, and, even, semiconductors from the vantages of international policy, finance, and corporate procurement activities. His earlier roles were Head of Commodity Research at Kraft Foods, Executive Director at Texas State Pension Review Board, and an Analyst at the International Monetary Fund. Through these roles, Paul's articles appear in multiple publications; including the IMF's World Economic Outlook.



Pisan Pongsapitch
Inspector-General of the Office of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives, Thailand

Pisan Pongsapitch has actively participated in the establishment process of international food standards for 26 years and has worked in the establishment of national standards for agricultural commodity and food standards for 11 years. Previously he was Deputy Secretary General at

Thailand National Bureau of Agricultural Commodity and Food Standards (ACFS) and before that Mr. Pongsapitch worked at the Thai Industrial Standards Institute (TISI). His areas of expertise include national and international food standards, food safety and risk assessment, quality management system in food industry, management of hygiene system and HACCP in food industry, Good Agricultural Practices, Inspection of food industry according to related standards and HACCP system and hygiene system in food factory. Mr. Pongsapitch holds a Bachelor's Degree in Agricultural Product Development from Kasetsart University, Thailand and a Master's degree in Food Technology from University of New South Wales, Australia.



Duangjan Wichalin Rice Farmer in Ubon Ratchathani, Thailand

Duangchan Wichalin is a leader of farmers' groups that works towards sustainable rice cultivation in Ubon Ratchathani province. She grew up with farming in her blood with a firm belief that conventional farming methods are the best. But when she took part in training course offered by the Better Rice Initiative Asia project, she started to have a broader spectrum of sustainability and saw that there are technologies that help to improve quality of rice and profitability. Following the Sustainable Rice

Platform Standard for Sustainable Rice Cultivation, her rice production is now twice the usual amount and her input costs are cut by 15%.



Diederik (Diehan) Pretorius Compliance & Sustainability Director, Herba Bangkok

Diederik (Diehan) Pretorius is the Director of Compliance & Sustainability and the acting Plant Manager for Herba Bangkok with extensive experience in quality and ethical compliance and operations in the food and food accessories production industry. Diehan has served on the Board of the Sustainable Rice Platform (SRP) for two terms (2018 and 2019). He has also been an active member of the SRP Work Group on Farmer Support, Performance Measurement, and Assurance, with main focus on

developing the SRP Standard Version 2.0 and the SRP Assurance Scheme. Diehan also represents the private sector on the Steering Committee of the Thai Rice NAMA project, which works in the central plains of Thailand.
